

March Financial Reporting & Expenses

Succeeding this cover page are the STRS Ohio financial reports & expenses for the period ending March 31, 2024. The reports that follow are:

- *Statement of Changes in Net Position* This statement reflects fiscal year-to-date additions and deductions to the plans' net position. Items such as contributions, investment income and benefit payments are included in this financial report.
- Actual Expenses vs. Budget This report reflects current month operating expenses and fiscal yearto-date expenses compared to fiscal year-to-date pro-rata budgeted amounts approved by the Board. In addition to operating expenses, a similar comparison is made of capital expenses.
- *Expense Notes* This report provides helpful explanations around larger or infrequent expenses.
- *Detailed Operating Expenses* This report provides the specific companies or individuals paid by STRS Ohio for operating expenses during the month.

STRS Ohio's funds are held in trust for the sole benefit of the retirement system's members and their beneficiaries. Benefits paid by STRS Ohio are funded by contributions from Ohio's public educators and their employers and the investment returns generated by the assets in which those contributions are invested. STRS receives no general revenue funds — in other words, none of the State of Ohio's budget is expended to support STRS Ohio's benefits or operations.

STRS Ohio' operating expenses are paid solely out of investment returns — no member contributions or tax dollars are expended. STRS Ohio's operating budget is approved by the retirement system's board of trustees, who under Ohio law act as fiduciaries to the retirement system's members. Additionally, prior to approval by the STRS Ohio Board, the operating budget is, by law, reviewed by the Ohio Retirement Study Council, which is comprised of members of the Ohio House and Senate, three members appointed by the Governor, as well as the executive directors of Ohio's five public retirement systems.

March 2024 Expense Notes

General Comments

Actual fiscal year-to-date operating expenses total \$83.0 million which is approximately \$4.9 million under expected budget.

Compensation and Fringe Benefits

Unused Vacation and Sick Leave includes payment to one separated and two retiring associates.

Professional and Technical Services

<u>Audit</u> includes fees for the annual financial statement and annual GASB 68 and 75 audits. Monthly investment board consultant services are included in <u>Investment Consultant</u>. <u>Other</u> <u>Consulting Services</u> includes the annual CEM benchmarking study and external board governance services. Annual licensing fees for global securities are included in <u>Quotation and</u> <u>Analytic Services</u>.

Repairs and Maintenance

<u>Building Maintenance and Equipment</u> includes quarterly building automation system and monthly HVAC maintenance. <u>Data Processing Equipment</u> includes quarterly STaRS maintenance and annual support for STaRS automated testing tool. Semi-annual fire sprinkler inspections and fire system maintenance are included in <u>Safety and Security Equipment</u>.

Communications

Included in <u>Postage</u> are costs associated with the defined contribution investment annual financial report.

Capital Budget

Capital items for March include payment for the cloud-based investment portfolio system.

Capital Budget Carryover

The capital budget carryover includes payment for the cloud-based financial management system.
