April Financial Reporting & Expenses

Succeeding this cover page are the STRS Ohio financial reports & expenses for the period ending April 28, 2023. The unaudited reports that follow are:

- Statement of Changes in Net Position This statement reflects fiscal year-to-date additions and deductions to the plans' net position. Items such as contributions, investment income and benefit payments are included in this financial report.
- Actual Expenses vs. Budget This report reflects current month operating expenses and fiscal year-to-date expenses compared to fiscal year-to-date pro-rata budgeted amounts approved by the Board. In addition to operating expenses, a similar comparison is made of capital and State of Ohio expenses.
- Expense Notes This report provides helpful explanations around larger or infrequent expenses.
- *Detailed Operating Expenses* This report provides the specific companies or individuals paid by STRS Ohio for operating expenses during the month.

STRS Ohio's funds are held in trust for the sole benefit of the retirement system's members and their beneficiaries. Benefits paid by STRS Ohio are funded by contributions from Ohio's public educators and their employers and the investment returns generated by the assets in which those contributions are invested. STRS receives no general revenue funds — in other words, none of the State of Ohio's budget is expended to support STRS Ohio's benefits or operations.

STRS Ohio' operating expenses are paid solely out of investment returns — no member contributions or tax dollars are expended. STRS Ohio's operating budget is approved by the retirement system's board of trustees, who under Ohio law act as fiduciaries to the retirement system's members. Additionally, prior to approval by the STRS Ohio Board, the operating budget is, by law, reviewed by the Ohio Retirement Study Council, which is comprised of members of the Ohio House and Senate, three members appointed by the Governor, as well as the executive directors of Ohio's five public retirement systems.

April 2023 Expense Notes

General Comments

Actual fiscal year-to-date operating expenses total \$90.9 million, which is approximately \$2.0 million under the expected budget.

Compensation and Fringe Benefits

Unused Vacation and Sick Leave includes payment to one retiring and two separated associates.

Professional and Technical Services

Actuary includes analysis of sustainable benefit enhancement plan and pension and health care valuation services. One quarter of global custody, collateral and investment performance charges are included in <u>Custodial Banking Fees</u>. Retiree health care information services are included in <u>Data Management and Analytics</u>. Quarterly retainer fees are included in <u>Insurance Consultant</u>. Quarterly investment board consultant services and monthly alternative investment consultant fees are included in <u>Investment Consultant</u>. <u>Legal Fees</u> include fees paid to outside counsel. Quarterly retainer fees for two REIC members are included in Real Estate Contract Services

Repairs and Maintenance

<u>Building Maintenance and Equipment</u> includes quarterly building automation system maintenance and repairs. Data Processing Equipment includes annual maintenance for STaRS database and PeopleSoft.

Supplies and Materials

Equipment Supplies include laptops, monitors, and workstations.

Other Expenses

Member counseling and education meeting room charges are included in <u>Member/Employer</u> Education Programs.

State of Ohio Expenses

Quarterly fees were paid to the <u>Ohio Retirement Study Council</u> and <u>Ohio Attorney General</u> representation fees were paid in April.

Capital Budget

Capital items for April include payments for audio visual equipment upgrades, replacement fire pump and the chiller rebuild.

Capital Budget Carryover

The capital budget carryover includes payment for the replacement cloud-based investment portfolio system.
