

January Financial Reporting & Expenses

Succeeding this cover page are the STRS Ohio financial reports & expenses for the period ending January 31, 2024. The reports that follow are:

- Statement of Changes in Net Position This statement reflects fiscal year-to-date additions and deductions to the plans' net position. Items such as contributions, investment income and benefit payments are included in this financial report.
- Actual Expenses vs. Budget This report reflects current month operating expenses and fiscal year-to-date expenses compared to fiscal year-to-date pro-rata budgeted amounts approved by the Board. In addition to operating expenses, a similar comparison is made of capital expenses.
- Expense Notes This report provides helpful explanations around larger or infrequent expenses.
- *Detailed Operating Expenses* This report provides the specific companies or individuals paid by STRS Ohio for operating expenses during the month.

STRS Ohio's funds are held in trust for the sole benefit of the retirement system's members and their beneficiaries. Benefits paid by STRS Ohio are funded by contributions from Ohio's public educators and their employers and the investment returns generated by the assets in which those contributions are invested. STRS receives no general revenue funds — in other words, none of the State of Ohio's budget is expended to support STRS Ohio's benefits or operations.

STRS Ohio' operating expenses are paid solely out of investment returns — no member contributions or tax dollars are expended. STRS Ohio's operating budget is approved by the retirement system's board of trustees, who under Ohio law act as fiduciaries to the retirement system's members. Additionally, prior to approval by the STRS Ohio Board, the operating budget is, by law, reviewed by the Ohio Retirement Study Council, which is comprised of members of the Ohio House and Senate, three members appointed by the Governor, as well as the executive directors of Ohio's five public retirement systems.

January 2024 Expense Notes

General Comments

Actual fiscal year-to-date operating expenses total \$68.0 million which is approximately \$4.6 million under expected budget.

Compensation and Fringe Benefits

<u>Salary and Wages</u> and associated fringe benefits were back to normal levels in January with the typical two paydays per month. <u>Unused Vacation and Sick Leave</u> costs and associated fringe benefits include the annual vacation and sick leave payments for associates and payment to two retiring associates. <u>Educational Assistance</u> was provided for five associates in January.

Professional and Technical Services

Actuary includes monthly pension and health care valuation services and plan design lever analysis. One quarter of global custody, collateral and performance charges are included in Custodial Banking Fees. Retiree health care information services are included in Data Management and Analytics. A quarterly retainer was paid to the Insurance Consultant. Quarterly investment board consultant and alternative investment consultant fees are included in Investment Research Services includes annual fees for credit analysis, quarterly fees for trade management system and semi-annual fees for fundamental research services. Other Consulting Services include semi-annual fees for Gartner information technology services.

Repairs and Maintenance

<u>Building Maintenance and Equipment</u> includes building automation system maintenance. <u>Data Processing Equipment</u> includes annual enterprise print and job scheduling software and Maximis automated testing tool. <u>Property Tax and Leases</u> includes half-year real estate taxes.

Communications

<u>Postage and Printing</u> includes costs associated with mailing the federal 1099-R tax forms and active member newsletters.

Supplies and Materials

Equipment Supplies include replacement laptops, monitors, and phones.

Other Expenses

<u>Dues and Licenses</u> include membership fees to the National Conference on Public Employee Retirement Systems, National Council of Real Estate Investment Fiduciaries, and Public Pension Financial Forum. Training includes ethics and compliance training.

State of Ohio Expenses

Quarterly fees for the Ohio Retirement Study Council were paid in January.

Capital Budget

Capital items for January include payment for the cloud-based investment portfolio system and replacement fire control panels.

Capital Budget Carryover
The capital budget carryover includes payment for the replacement data center cooling system and cloud-based financial management system.
