#### May Board Actions Shared With Retirees, Active Members



- Following the May Retirement Board meeting, retirees and active members who would be impacted by approved benefit changes received an email to outline the enhancements
  - Informed benefit recipients about 1% cost-of-living adjustment for fiscal 2024
  - Informed active members about the extension of unreduced retirement eligibility at 34 years
  - News also shared via STRS Ohio's website, social media
  - Shared that STRS Ohio's online calculators are updated to reflect these changes

#### Benefits Counseling Appointments Top 11,000 in Fiscal 2023



- Benefits counseling continues to be offered virtually or in person (in Columbus)
  - Benefits counselors met with about 11,000 members between July 2022 and the end of May 2023, roughly the same number as last year
  - Overall attendance is expected to be about equal to last year

### Legislative Update



- Primary focus of the legislature is on the state's biennial budget
  - House passed its version in late April, followed by Senate deliberations
- Ohio Retirement Study Council (ORSC) did not meet this month
- House Concurrent Resolution 6 amended to include Government Pension Offset
  - No subsequent action taken
- Governmental Relations staff continuing conversations with legislators relative to increasing employer contributions

#### Retirement Plan Reselection Concludes, Most Members Remain in Current Plan



- This spring, approximately 1,680 members who elected STRS Ohio's Defined Contribution Plan or Combined Plan had their one-time option to change plans
- This option begins in the member's fifth year of membership
- STRS Ohio notified members eligible to change plans in early 2023, then followed up with a packet that described their plan choices in more detail
- Default choice is to remain in the current plan
- 94% will remain in their current plan, while 6% opted to switch to another plan

# Employer Education Team Leads In-person and Virtual Training Sessions



- Spring is a busy season for our Employer Education team
  - The team presented an in-person, half-day workshop on annual reporting basics in Canton, Columbus, Findlay and Mason
    - Topics included annual reporting, withdrawal certification, reporting service credit and retirement reporting
  - The team also presented a webinar on service credit to more than 100 attendees
    - Focused on how to properly calculate service credit using days worked
    - Interactive presentation uses real-life scenarios and goes step-by-step to reach the correct calculations
  - Employers appreciate having both in-person and virtual training options from STRS Ohio
