JUDGMENT ENTRY

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that,

1. Upon becoming eligible and applying for a service retirement benefit from the State Teachers Retirement System of Ohio (STRS Ohio), _____ (*name of STRS Ohio member*) shall select a plan of payment that is a Joint and Survivor Annuity providing for payment continuing after his/her death to a designated beneficiary or beneficiaries and shall designate _____ (*name of former spouse*) as the beneficiary to receive a lifetime allowance, which is _____ % (percent) of the marital portion of _____ 's (*name of STRS Ohio member*) reduced monthly benefit under the Joint and Survivor Annuity plan of payment.
2. The numerator of the fraction to be used in the calculation of the marital portion is _____ years, which is the number of years during which the _____ (*name of STRS Ohio member*) was both a contributing member of the public retirement program and married to _____ (*name of former spouse*). The denominator of the fraction of the marital portion will be determined by the public retirement program at the time _____ (*name of STRS Ohio member*) elects to take a benefit or lump-sum payment, shall be _____ 's (*name of STRS Ohio member*) total years of service credit used in the calculation of the benefit paid by the public retirement program.
3. _____ (*name of STRS Ohio member*) shall provide STRS Ohio with a certified copy of this order no later than thirty (30) days from the date of issuance of this order.
4. The court reserves jurisdiction to enforce these provisions.
